Funding Arts Broward, FAB!, is a non-profit organization dedicated to preserving and cultivating the arts in Broward County.

It was formed in response to the need for private financial support following drastic government budget cuts to arts funding.

Through a competitive grant process, annual awards are made to a myriad of non-profit visual and performing arts organizations in Broward County.

This is a participatory endeavor.

Members volunteer to review grant applications, conduct site visits, evaluate and recommend funding for specific projects. Grantees are then selected by a vote of the FAB! membership.

Dear FAB! Members and Friends,

Ten years ago a thought became an idea, which became a dream, which became a reality – and that reality is Funding Arts Broward! In May 2003, the first luncheon was held and the idea that was FAB! was introduced to the guests in attendance. The purpose of FAB! was to provide an additional funding source for qualified Broward County non-profit arts organizations. The idea was that each individual member would contribute \$1000 annually, 100% of which would make up a grant funding pool.

People enthusiastically embraced this idea and in May 2004 Funding Arts Broward awarded its first grants, totaling \$75,000, to 10 organizations.

In addition to our individual members we now have incredibly supportive corporate members contributing a minimum of \$3500 annually. Also, what has deepened our funding pool significantly is the support of our very special Funding Partners. These are individual FAB! members who give a minimum of \$2500 over and above their annual dues.

Ten years later our mission and purpose remain unchanged and our commitment to a thriving Broward County arts community is unwavering. As we celebrate our 10th Anniversary Season it is with great pride that we have surpassed \$1.8 million in funds awarded to more than 30 arts organizations in our community.
