Grant funding is accomplished from FAB's nearly 200 members, Corporate Partners, Individual Donors, and Private Foundations.








FAB'S IMPACT

In 2004, FAB's first grant pool raised and awarded \$75,000 to the Broward arts community. Almost 20 years later, FAB has continued to grow and has awarded over \$4 million to 65 arts organizations.



YOUTH IMPACT

Art sparks a child's interest in a new subject, teaches and develops life skills, creates an environment that promotes discussion, ignites collaboration, and inspires creativity.



ENTERTAINMENT IMPACT

Performances and exhibitions enlighten lives, relieve stress, lift spirits, and often inspire involvement in the community.



SOCIAL IMPACT

Art invites people to broaden the dialogue, to tell diverse and inclusive stories that instill a sense of connectivity. Art has the power to spark engaging and beneficial conversation including diversity, equity, and inclusion.



ECONOMIC IMPACT

Broward County's nonprofit arts and culture sector is a \$141.2 million industry, supporting more than 11,000 full-time equivalent jobs and generating more than \$40 million in revenue for Broward County.

Increase the existing grant caps for FAB's longstanding "Program Grants" and fund the "Education Grants" program. Expansion helps ensure that all in our community can find inspiration, entertainment, and connection through the arts.



BUILD

Introduce a multi-year "New Works" grant category to foster creativity, and initiate collaborative grants to develop strategic relationships between other funding partners interested in advancing the arts in our community.



INVEST

Investment in the development of art philanthropy in Broward County. To reach this untapped potential is important. Further investment in FAB's infrastructure is necessary to support new initiatives.



ENDOW

Creating an endowment is a strategic step for FAB that will enable planned multi-year grant support, continued program and education grant support, and FAB's infrastructure support.
