

It Began With A SPARK!



- One of the key findings coming out of the Enriching the Arts report was the glaring gaps and need for more arts education in our K-12 public schools in Broward.
- ♣ In October 2024, two special multiyear grants of \$150,000 each were made to two local organizations – Arts Prevails Project and South Florida Symphony Orchestra – to expand already established and impactful art education programs in Broward County's schools.
- ♣ Funding was made possible through the Spark campaign and a matching grant from the Community Foundation of Broward.

- ↓ 15 schools across Broward County

Teaching Artists Are Providing:



- Immersive introductory music sessions via 'Jump Start Camps' at Indian Ridge, Coral Springs, and Driftwood Middle Schools.
- ♣ 'After-School Strings Program' at Sea Castle Elementary where a 25-piece student orchestra was formed.
- Live performance opportunities.

Music Matters

Band Student Academic Performance Proficiency Gains: 78% - 12 points higher than the overall school proficiency

Indian Ridge Middle School becomes the first school to report standardized test data showing significant measurable evidence supporting the impact of South Florida Symphony Orchestra's SiS program on academic achievement – specifically in Reading/ELS.

One out of nine students (11%) at Indian Ridge Middle School is a band student.

Both South Florida Symphony Orchestra and Art Prevails Project are working with schools to encourage reporting academic data in the future.



Advanced Proficiency Gains (Level 4-5): 52% - 9 points higher than the overall school gains.

Because of the work that SiS Teaching Artists did with my students, we delivered the best concert we've ever performed. Be the SPARK! funds were used to EXPAND THE EXISTING "Write it Out" program from one semester to TWO semesters at existing schools, and the program was also introduced to FIVE new schools and reached 144 new students in the Spring of 2025.

"WRITE IT OUT"

- Pairs resident teaching artists with a group of students for the semester.
- Creative writing activities with a primary focus on poetry and prose, occurring weekly for 10 weeks.
- Supplement teacher's instructional focus calendar and creates a unique learning experience through collaboration with the teacher that engages students
- Culminates in a poetry reading and published chapbook of the students' work.



"Speak Your Peace" was introduced to 27 NEW students at one NEW school during the spring of 2025.



"SPEAK YOUR PEACE"

- ♣ A Theatre project that uses creative expression and performance workshop series to explore topics and issues that matter to them.
- ♣ Facilitated by Art Prevails Project performers and educators, Speak Your Peace guides students through the process of self-discovery and provides amplification for student voices.
- The project culminates with a multidisciplinary performance created by workshop participants in partnership with Art Prevails Project staff.



We invested in helping Art Prevails Project train and expand its corp of teaching artists.









New Arts Discipline Pages
